



Finding Your Laptop's Processor Generation

1. Press the **Windows** key  on your keyboard and start typing *System*. Choose **System Information**, which will show **Processor** information including the name, number, and speed of the processor (example below).
2. If the **Windows** key is not available on your keyboard, use your mouse to go to the Windows icon located on the bottom-left corner of your screen, right-click, and choose **System**. Look up the processor's name and number in the **Processor** information (example below).
3. The Number following the Processor Model indicates the generation number. For example, the computer in example A shows an Intel Core™ i5-5300U Processor. Intel Core™ i5 is the model. The first digit following the dash (5) is the generation of the processor: 5th Generation.
4. Example B shows the same view for AMD processor. In this example, AMD Ryzen 5 is the model and the first digit following the model (2) is the generation: 2nd generation.


Examples A and B below show the case when choosing **System** and Example C shows **System Information**.


